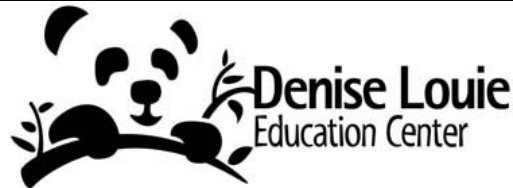


Eligibility Application Instructions



Early Head Start

Please include the following documents to complete your child's eligibility application:

<input type="checkbox"/> 1. Eligibility Application	<p>Completed Eligibility Application Form, signed by legal parent/guardian and dated.</p> <p>Please complete all sections of the application.</p>
<input type="checkbox"/> 2. Signed and Initialed Exchange of Information Consent Forms (Child/Adult)	<p>Please complete Exchange of Information forms with contact information for agencies you are receiving services from. Initial required areas. Sign and date.</p>
<input type="checkbox"/> 3. Proof of Family Income: (For all members of the household) Children/families may be categorically eligible if: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Receiving Temporary Assistance to Needy Families (TANF) • Receiving Social Security Income (SSI) • Meet the official federal definition of "Homeless" or • Child has Foster Care status 	<p>Any 1 of these listed showing income(s) for the last calendar year or the past 12 months:</p> <p>Income Tax form, W-2 forms, current dated DSHS Grant Award document, Washington State Employment Security Office document showing record of previous 12 months, Social Security benefits, Veteran's benefits, Military income, Alimony payments, Pay stubs for last 12 months, Employer letter stating total gross earnings.</p> <p>If receiving SSI or TANF please provide documentation showing current status or information (award number, case worker name and phone number) for verification.</p> <p>*NOTE* Families must live within the recruitment/service areas for DLEC as defined in the City of Seattle/SeaTac Early Head Start Grantees Memorandum of Agreement</p>
